

15	STIPULATION AND ORDER		
16	Respondents Donald E. Dougherty and Groves Mobile Home Real Estate, Inc.		
17	("Respondents") and WAYNE STRUMPFER, Acting California Corporations Commissioner		
18	("Commissioner"), having received and reviewed the Proposed Decision and Order of		
19	Administrative Law Judge Ralph B. Dash dated July 26, 2005, and the Order of Rejection of		
20	Proposed Decision dated November 4, 2005, hereby enter into this stipulation in lieu of further		
21	proceedings in this matter. Accordingly,		
22	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties as follows:		
23	1. The parties voluntarily choose to enter into this stipulation as a means of achieving a full		
24	and final resolution of the matter.		
25	2. The Commissioner hereby agrees to withdraw the Desist and Refrain Order issued April		
26	4, 2005, and hereby adopts this supulation and anached order as the Decision by Settlement in this		
27	matter. Attached as Exhibit 1 is a copy of the executed Order withdrawing the Desist and Refrain		
28	Order.

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3. This stipulation and order shall constitute the Decision by Settlement in this matter in lieu
 of any decision based upon the hearing in this matter held on May 24, 2005. The Decision by
 Sentement is made pursuant to Government Code section 11415.60.

4 4. Respondents acknowledge the jurisdiction of the Department of Corporations through
 5 Acting California Corporations Commissioner Wayne Strumpfer to settle this matter.

5. The parties agree to dismissal of the action,

6. The parties acknowledge that the Desist and Refrain Order issued on April 4, 2005 is a
public record accessible to the public pursuant to the Public Records Act, section 6250 <u>et seq</u>. of the
Government Code. The parties also acknowledge that this Decision by Settlement, the
Order withdrawing the Desist and Refrain Order, the Office of Administrative Hearings' Proposed
Decision and the Department's Order of Rejection of Proposed Decision issued on November 4,
2005, will be posted on the Department of Corporations' website.

13 7. As of the date that both parties have executed this stipulation, the parties fully and forever 14 release and discharge each other, and each of any of their employees, officers, directors, investors, 15 affiliates, heirs and assigns, from any and all claims, rights, demands, liabilities, obligations, 16 damages, actions and causes of action, of every kind and nature, in law, equity or otherwise, known 17 and disclosed, arising out of or relating to the specific facts and allegations that were the subject of 18 the hearing on May 24, 2005, provided that the foregoing release and discharge shall not apply to 19 any of the obligations of the parties under this stipulation.

8. The parties agree that this stipulation may be signed in counterparts and facsimile copies
accepted as the original, if necessary. This stipulation shall be considered fully binding as if the
parties had executed the same document at the same time. This stipulation constitutes the entire
agreement between the parties with respect to this case. Moreover, the terms of this stipulation
cannot be amended except in writing, signed by all the parties thereto.

9. This Decision by Settlement is subject to necessary approval. In the event that any part of
the Decision failes to obtain necessary approval the entire stipulation will be rendered null and void,
and the parties will retain all rights under the Administrative Procedure Act.
