14	1. At all relevant times, Sunshine Fresh Produce ("SFP") is or was a California sole
15	proprietorship.
16	2. At all relevant times, Willingham Farms ("WF") is or was a California sole
17	proprietorship.
18	3. At all relevant times Dennis Willingham is or was a control person and principal of
19	SFP and WF.
20	4. At all relevant times Brenda Willingham is or was a control person and principal of
21	SFP and WF.
22	5. Beginning in or about January of 1997 and continuing to about November 2001,
23	Dennis Willingham and Brenda Willingham offered or sold securities in the form of
24	promissory notes, joint venture agreements and investment contracts in SFP and WF.
25	6. Through the direct solicitation of individuals, Dennis and Brenda Willingham offered
26	and sold at least \$20,000,000 of securities in SFP and WF.

	-1- DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER

The purported business of SFP and WF was to operate a business that brokered
 strawberries grown in and around Ventura County, California. Later, Dennis Willingham and
 Brenda Willingham told investors that they were also growing strawberries.

8. These securities were offered or sold in this state in issuer transactions. The
Department of Corporations has not issued a permit or other form of qualification authorizing
any person to offer and sell these securities in this state.

Based on the foregoing findings, the California Corporations Commissioner is of the opinion that the promissory notes, joint venture agreements and investment contracts offered and sold by Dennis Willingham and Brenda Willingham in SFP and WF are securities subject to qualification under the California Corporate Securities Law of 1968 and are being or have been offered or sold without being qualified.

Pursuant to Section 25532 of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968, Dennis Willingham, Brenda Willingham, Sunshine Fresh Produce, and Willingham Farms are hereby ordered to desist and refrain from directly or indirectly offering or selling in the State of California, securities in the form of promissory notes, joint venture agreements and/or investment contracts, unless and until qualification has been made under said law. The sale of such securities is subject to qualification under said law and such securities are being or have been offered for sale without first being so qualified.

This Order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and consistent with the purposes, policies, and provisions of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968.
