Commissioner of Corporations of the State of California v. Michael L. Jackson and Janice Jackson; the petition having been considered, the Commissioner of Business Oversight (Commissioner) finds that:

Petitioner is not entitled to reinstatement of management or control of an escrow agent for the following reasons:

- 1. Petitioner has yet to accept responsibility for the violations that occurred at the Riverside branch of Ontario Escrow Service, Inc. (Ontario) while she was employed as the escrow manager. The violations involved misuse of trust funds, a trust account shortage, and failure to reconcile a trust account, which are serious violations of the Escrow Law.
- 2. Petitioner has submitted no evidence of any educational training in the intervening years or proof of rehabilitation save and except for her own self-serving comments about escrow positions she has held at a former escrow company and unnamed title insurance companies.

 Petitioner submits no letters from these employers attesting to her job duties or performance.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition be denied.
