21	Accusation to revoke the California Financing Law (CFL) license(s) of Respondent, Sadnara		
22	Corporation (Respondent), pursuant to Financial Code section 22714. The Commissioner alleges		
23	and charges as follows:

25	Statement of Facts		
26	1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction	n over the licensing and regulation of persons and	
27	entities engaged in the business of finance lending or brokering under the California Financing Law		
28	(CFL) (Fin. Code, § 22000 et seq.).		
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2.	Respondent is a California corporation, with a principal place of business at 1415		
East 17th Street, Suite 240-A Santa Ana, California 92705.			
3.	Respondent is licensed as a finance lender and broker under the CFL with main		
license number 60DBO-22715.			
4.	Financial Code section 22159 requires CFL licensees to file an annual report with the		
Commissioner by March 15 of each year reflecting the licensee's previous calendar year's business			
and operations (Annual Report).			

- 5. Financial Code section 22715, subdivision (b) authorizes the Commissioner to issue an order assessing a monetary penalty against licensees for filing the Annual Report after the March deadline. (Penalty Order)
- 6. Pursuant to Financial Code section 22715, subdivision (d), if a licensee does not file a written request for a hearing within 30 days of the date of service of the Penalty Order, the Penalty Order becomes a final order of the Commissioner, and the licensee must pay the penalty within five business days of the date the Penalty Order becomes final.
- 7. On April 2, 2018, Respondent filed its 2017 Annual Report, 12 business days after the March 15, 2018 deadline.
- 8. On May 25, 2018, the Commissioner issued and served an Order imposing a penalty (Penalty Order) on Respondent, license number(s) 60DBO-22715, imposing a \$4,000.00 penalty.
- 9. No written request for a hearing was received within 30 days of service of the Penalty Order assessed against Respondent, making the Penalty Order final.
- 10. Respondent has not paid the Penalty Order within five business days of the Penalty Order being deemed a final order of the Commissioner.

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2 **Authority to Revoke Respondent's CFL License** 3 Financial Code section 22714, subdivision (a), provides: 4 The commissioner shall suspend or revoke any license, upon notice and reasonable opportunity to be heard, if the 5 commissioner finds any of the following: (1) The licensee has failed to comply with any demand, ruling, or 6 requirement of the commissioner made pursuant to and within the 7 authority of this division 8 III. 9 **Prayer** 10 11. The Commissioner finds that by failing to pay the Penalty Order assessed against 11 Respondent within five business days of the order being deemed a final order of the Commissioner, 12 the Respondent has failed to comply with a demand, ruling, or requirement of the Commissioner 13 made pursuant to and within the authority of the CFL, and it is in the best interests of the public to 14 revoke the CFL license(s) of Respondent. 15 12.
