26	1. At all relevant times, Tounjian Advisory Group, LLC (Tounjian) was a Florida limited liability company which held a valid and unrevoked investment adviser certificate issued by the

28	Commissioner on June 7, 2016, pursuant to Corp	porations Code section 25230. Tounjian is located at	

8870 Daniels Parkway, Fort Meyers, Florida 33912.

- 2. On or about March 14, 2018, the Commissioner notified Tounjian that it must designate an email address to receive an online examination form. The Commissioner did not receive a response from Tounjian. The Commissioner therefore sent subsequent emails to email addresses designated in the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority, Inc.'s (FINRA) Central Registration Depository (CRD) system.
- 3. On or about October 2, 2018, the Commissioner sent the online examination to Tounjian to an email address designated by Tounjian on CRD. The Commissioner informed Tounjian that the online examination must be completed and submitted by November 16, 2018.
- 4. The Commissioner sent four emails, dated October 15, 2018, October 26 or 29, 2018, November 5, 2018, and November 12, 2018, to Tounjian's designated email address, reminding Tounjian of the November 16, 2018 deadline to complete and submit the online examination.
- 5. Despite the Commissioner's efforts, Tounjian failed to timely complete and submit the online examination by the November 16, 2018 deadline.
- 6. Corporations Code section 25241 requires every investment adviser licensed by the Commissioner to maintain books and records, file reports with the Commissioner, and submit to examination by the Commissioner, as the Commissioner deems necessary or appropriate in the public interest or for the protection of investors.

Therefore, and with good cause appearing, it is hereby ORDERED under the provisions of Corporations Code section 25242, subdivision (c), that Tounjian Advisory Group, LLC's investment adviser certificate is summarily revoked for violations of Corporations Code section 25241. This order is effective immediately. This revocation precludes Tounjian Advisory Group, LLC from engaging in normal investment adviser activities that includes soliciting or facilitating new business, including for existing clients.

This revocation does not preclude Tounjian Advisory Group, LLC from engaging in activities necessary to the winding down of the business such as liquidating transactions, transferring accounts, forwarding any checks received to clearing firms, responding to regulatory inquiries, and

1	otherwise fielding client/customer inquiries for account servicing or document requests, among other	
2	things.	
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	This order is necessary, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and consistent	
4	with the purposes, policies, and provisions of the Corporate Securities Law of 1968.
