control of an escrow agent for the following reasons:

- Petitioner has yet to accept responsibility for the violations that occurred at First National Escrow while she was escrow manager. The violations involved misuse of funds, including "lapping" of funds, failure to follow escrow instructions, favoring one party over another in escrows, and failure to supervise employees, which are serious violations of the Escrow Law.
- 2. Petitioner has submitted no evidence of any educational training in the intervening years or proof of rehabilitation.
 - It is in the public interest to deny the petition for reinstatement. 3.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Petition be denied.
